Anticoagulants : Deep vein thrombosis, secondary prophylaxis

Antimicrobials : Pneumonia, lower urinary tract infection, cellulitis and erysipelas, candidiasis

Cardiovascular drugs : Heart failure, angina pectoris, hypertension, diabetes mellitus type 2, atrium fibrillation,

Respiratory drugs : Asthma and COPD

Psychotropics : Depression, delirium, anxiety/sleeping problems Emergency medicines : Fluid management, anaphylaxis, toxicology

Other : Nausea, reflux (GERD)
